

## Frequently Asked Questions - Enrolments

Q: I want to enrol my child at CPAHS. What do I have to do?

If you would like to enrol your child as a local student and live within our designated drawing area, you will be required to complete the requisite enrolment forms and provide proof of address.

If you live within our drawing area, your child does not have to audition to attend CPAHS but they must audition if they wish to enrol in a specialist performing arts class.

Students who live out of our drawing area must audition in one of the performing arts disciplines to attend (dance, drama, music - instrumental and vocal, circus arts).

Q: My child is in year 6. How do I get enrolment papers for next year?

If your child attends a public school they will provide you with an Expression Of Interest (EOI) in March to complete and return to them. This is the commencement of the enrolment process. Please speak to your child's school or contact us directly if you require further information.

If your child currently attends a Catholic or Independent school, please call us and we can provide specific details regarding our enrolment process.

Q: My child has successfully auditioned and we have accepted the position, what happens now?

To accept the position, you must complete and return the Conditions of Acceptance form. Following this, you will receive an Application to Enrol package that will need to be completed and returned by the due date. Once processed, you will receive a letter confirming your placement.

Q: What additional papers do I need to submit for enrolment?

When you return the Application to Enrol you need to also need to submit three pieces of proof of residence, a copy of the child's birth certificate or passport, a copy of their NAPLAN results (unless already submitted with an audition application), plus all the forms that were included in the package.

Q: When is Orientation Day?

Orientation Day is usually held at the beginning of December. All successful applicants will be provided with information regarding Orientation Day before the designated date.
